### Directions For Use

Light Duty – Dilute 1 to 5 Parts Water  
Can be applied through a spray bottle, sponge or brush.  
For extremely soiled applications brush agitation may be required  
**REMOVE SOIL BY FULL RINSE WITH HOSE OR SPRAY BOTTLE**

### FIRST AID

**If swallowed:** Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor. **If on skin (or hair):** Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor. **If inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor. **If in eyes:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Store locked up. Dispose of contents/container to an approved waste disposal plant.  
**Fire fighting Instructions:** Use water spray or fog for cooling exposed containers. Exercise caution when fighting any chemical fire. Prevent fire-fighting water from entering environment.  
**Suitable extinguishing media:** Foam, Dry powder, carbon dioxide, water spray, sand.
