DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Follow dilution chart to determine proper dilution rate. Use weaker solutions for regular cleaning, depending on the amount and type of soil.

FOR FLOORS: Apply cleaner by mop, scrub with machine if desired, pick up with mop or vacuum, then

FOR EQUIPMENT & MACHINERY: Spray or wipe product onto surface, rinse lightly, then wipe dry. FOR AIRPLANES, TRUCK BODIES, Etc.: Spray cleaner onto surface and allow to work on soil for up to 5 minutes. Then scrub with a stiff brush and hose off with water. Product may be used on automobiles before waxing.

FOR SMALL PARTS: Dip into solution, rinse lightly, wipe dry.
